Spectators

Welcome to our 36th annual Oktoberfest! We are so excited to have you joining us again. We are beyond grateful that we have been given the opportunity to host, as there were many times this year that we were uncertain if it would be possible. But in order to be able to host this great competition, we need everyone's cooperation and dedication to guarantee the safest environment possible for everyone. Below you will find the requirements for participation. There are MANY changes from past years, so please read carefully. If you are found in violation, you will be asked to leave the facility and competition. These are guidelines that were set following rules and recommendations from our state, county, facility, and club, and are subject to change should stricter requirements be mandated.

Please stay home if you have any COVID symptoms, you or a member of your household are awaiting test results, you or a member of your household have tested positive in the last 14 days, or if you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is symptomatic.

- The LOC will not be limiting the number of spectators.
- All spectators will be required to complete a health screening and have temperatures taken upon entrance. *No skaters, chaperones, coaches, officials, or spectators will be allowed in the building if they cannot pass the health assessment.*
- While in the building, all patrons are required to wear a mask that properly covers their mouth and nose. They must be worn properly at all times. Face shields are not acceptable alone. They may only be worn in conjunction with a mask.
- Sanitizer is available throughout the facility. We encourage regular sanitizing and hand washing.
- Approved areas will be clearly marked. Please stay within the marked boxes to maintain proper distance from other spectators.
- Spectators will need to wait outside until 15 minutes before the event start time, then they enter the balcony viewing area to watch their *own skater's event only*. They must leave the building immediately following the conclusion of the event.
- Be courteous to our volunteers. They are making this event possible!

It is our hope that we can leave personal opinions at the door and follow all guidelines as set by the organizing committee, because that is the only way that these skaters will get the opportunity to participate in events like this.
